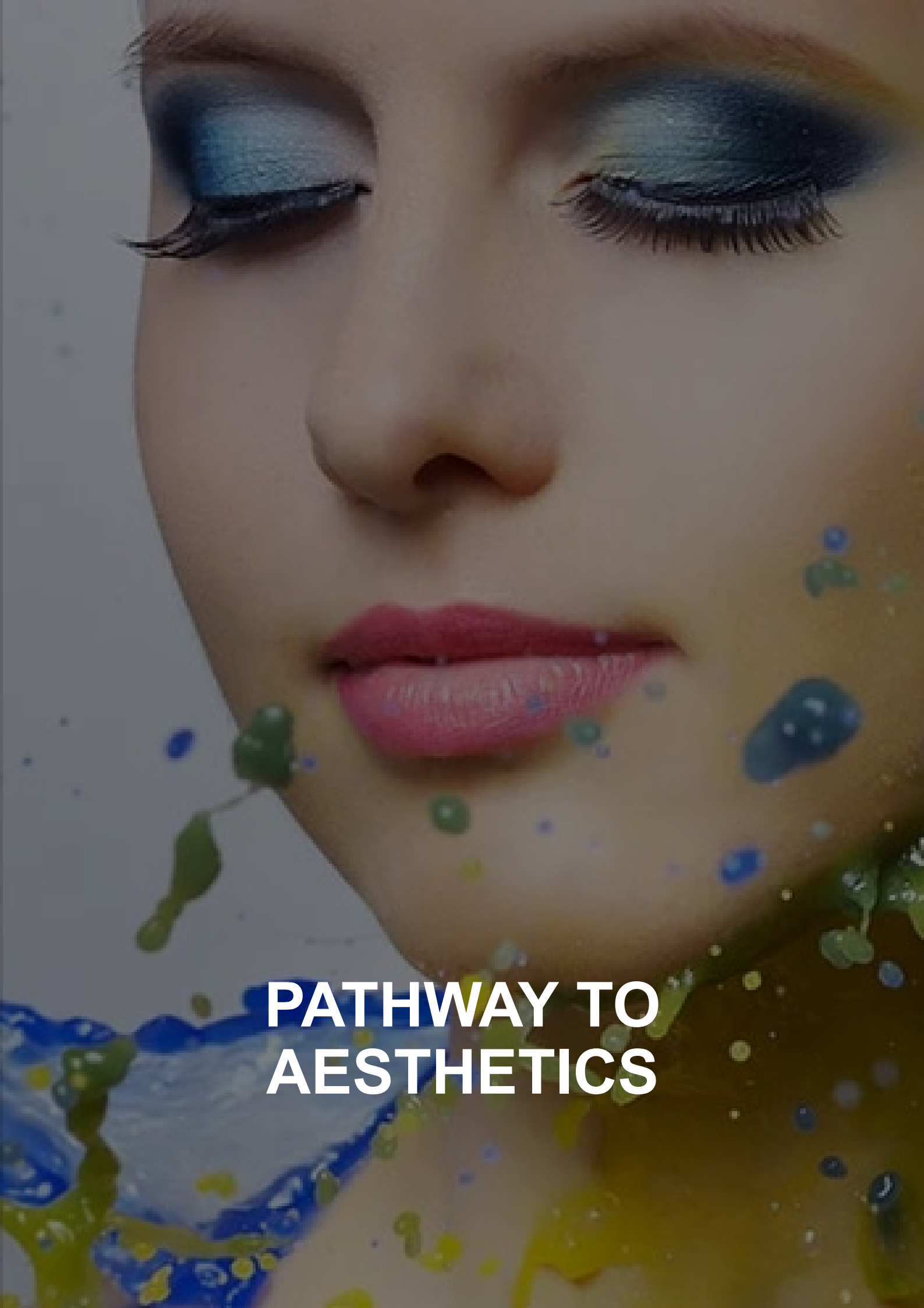
If you are Level 3 Beauty Therapy Qualified, or Health Care Professionals

Depends on your subject of interest, you can start at Level 4 and work your way up. For IQ Verify Skin Rejuvenation Scheme, it is required for all candidates to requalify every three years. This qualification allows non medics to access the JCCP register.

For practitioners who already have relevant experience in the subject, we have RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) scheme to transfer your experience into recognised certifications.

This is a preparation for work course which is based on capability and knowledge. The unit is about providing safe and effective skin rejuvenation treatments using either manual or automated micro needling devices with a needle depth of up to 0.5mm on the face and up to 1 mm on the body and superficial chemical peels. To complete the course successfully, learner will need to maintain effective health, safety and hygiene procedures throughout their work. Learners will need to provide a safe and effective micro needling and skin peel treatments. Learners will have a definition of the treatment and all of the subcomponent procedures that make up the treatment. They should know and understand benefits, effects, indications for and contraindications to each treatment. They will also understand how to evaluate and record outcomes of treatments and the provision of effective and detailed aftercare and homecare advice.
